Since the BCI program's inception in 2013, **94 PHD-LEVEL INTERNS** have engaged in internship opportunities with **28 EMPLOYERS** in diverse industries. The program has been featured in prominent journals include *Nature*, *Cell*, *Science News*, and *The Scientist*.

- Upload your application materials on Handshake by January 15th, 2023

2023 Application Timeline

- ✓ Nov. 15th, 2022: Internships posted to the BCI website; Application period begins
- ✓ Nov.-Jan. 2022.: BCI workshops for resume, cover letter, and interview prep
- ✓ Jan. 18th 2023: Application deadline
- ✓ **Feb. 2023**: Interviewing; Flexible start-dates throughout 2023 (based on you and the employer's availability)
